Current BDA Coaching Courses Available

Coaching is a very worthwhile, enjoyable and rewarding aspect of bowling.

The **Play Bowls Activator Module** is a 4 hour course and is an integral part of any club's recruitment programme. It equips volunteers and coaches with information and skills to offer a fun and informal introduction to the sport of bowls.

The **Level 1 course** takes 2 days and enables you to coach beginners and to run the Bowls4Fun programme in your club.

The **Level 2** course takes 5 days and further enables you to coach improvers through to competitive players in your club. It also enables you to assist experienced coaches who attend other clubs to coach a variety of skills according to the needs of the club being visited.

The **Disability Module** is a 4 hour course which is aimed at supporting coaches who are keen to work with bowlers who are disabled. It will increase awareness of the implications of working with a bowler who is disabled and offer a range of practical ideas on how to support their progress.

Safeguarding in Bowls - "Time to Listen" is a 4 hour bowls-specific workshop designed to support coaches and welfare officers in ensuring that all children and vulnerable adults are safe within their clubs.
