Surrey County Indoor Bowling Association played against SCBA & won on all 6 rinks & the match 146 – 88 (8 – 0). SCIBA retain the Crawford Cup 9 – 7.

The Indoor team lost 107 – 136 (1 – 7) in the outdoor match played in the summer.

Rules & Scoring:

Cecil Crawford presented a Trophy (Cecil Crawford Bowl) to be played for between the Executive Members of the Surrey County Bowling Association and the Executive Members of the Surrey County Indoor Bowling Association. It is intended to be a Fun game to promote the good spirit of Bowls between the Associations. The games to be played Twice Yearly, one Indoors and one outdoors the first to be played Indoors at the beginning of the Outdoors Presidential Year. The Trophy to be presented at the Annual Surrey County Dinner. A system of points score to decide the Winner 1 Point for a Winning Rink and 2 Points for winning the Match. The total Points over the two games will be 16. One player can only play for one team during the year the first match outdoors the second indoors. These Guidelines were discussed and put together by Cecil Crawford, Harry Braun and Jim Green in September 1996.
